Use this simple worksheet to plan your homeschool lessons with clarity and intention. It works for any subject or activity, and helps you stay focused on what your child should understand and be able to do as a result of the lesson.

Definitions

Learning Objective: What you want your child to understand.

Learning Outcome: What your child should be able to do as a result of that understanding.

Planning Steps

1. Choose the Topic:

What concept are you introducing?

2. Define the Learning Objective:

What should your child understand by the end of the lesson?

3. Define the Learning Outcome:

What should your child be able to do as a result of the lesson?

4. Choose a Simple Activity:

What activity will help teach this concept?

5. Check for Understanding:

How will you know your child understood the concept?

Example

Topic: Types of Clouds

Learning Objective: Understand the different types of clouds.

Learning Outcome: Be able to name and describe 3 types of clouds.

Activity: Read a book about clouds and draw them together.

Check: Ask your child to describe each type in their own words.
